Introduction

Along with partners, Warwickshire County Council (WCC) wants to ensure that residents have access to the right support over the winter months. We want to:

- Ensure that Warwickshire residents are aware of support services and techniques to help keep up with their household costs during the winter months and how they can stay warm and well
- Empower residents to help themselves and others.
- Increase awareness of availability and eligibility criteria of Pension Credit

The campaign will predominately signpost to the <u>Cost of Living website</u>, designed as a one-stop shop for practical and financial advice from county, district and borough councils and other partners, helping residents navigate information and assist public services to signpost and advise those needing support.
